TED は「よいアイデアを広めよう(Ideas Worth Spreading)」を理念とする非営利団体です。26 年前、カリフォリニアで4日間の講演会として始まって以来、世界を変えるアイデアを様々な活動で支援するまでに至りました。 TED では、世界の先頭を行く思想家や実行家たちが、自分の人生・体験についての講演を18分で行うことが求められます。その後、講演は TED.com で無料で視聴できるようになります。

■TEDx について

TEDx とは、TED の「よいアイデアを広めよう」の精神に基づいて世界各地で独自に運営されているプログラムです。各地の人々が一緒になって TED 本体と同様の体験を共有することができます。 TEDx のイベントでは、TEDTalks の映像とスピーカーの生の講演を鑑賞することで、深い議論が沸き起こり、小さなグループにも絆が生まれます。この各地で独自に運営されるイベントは「TEDx」と呼ばれています。「x」は独自に運営されている、ということを示しています。

Osaka University of Economics (President: Shunichiro Yamamoto / Located at 2-2-8 Osumi, Higashiyodogawa-ku, Osaka City) will hold "TEDxOUE" on September 30, 2022 (Friday), the 90th anniversary of the university's founding, at the Osumi Campus, where alumni and current students of the university who are active in various fields will take the stage and give talks about their experiences.

About TEDx, x = independently organized event

In the spirit of ideas worth spreading, TEDx is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share a TED-like experience. At a TEDx event, TED Talks video and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection. These local, self-organized events are branded TEDx, where x = independently organized TED event. The TED Conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events are self-organized. (Subject to certain rules and regulations.)

About TED

TED is a nonprofit organization devoted to Ideas Worth Spreading, often in the form of short talks delivered by leading thinkers and doers. Many of these talks are given at TED conferences, intimate TED Salons and thousands of independently organized TEDx events around the world. Videos of these talks are made available, free, on <u>TED.com</u> and other platforms. Audio versions of TED Talks are published to <u>TED Talks Daily</u>, available on all podcast platforms.
